AUA believes in need-blind admissions. We can help you finance your studies. Learn about the various tools available to support your educational journey. Your education comes first.

Citizens of the Republic of Armenia and Special Passport Holders receive an automatic 2,000,000 Υ annual subsidy off the total cost of their tuition. In addition, the University offers need-based and merit-based tuition assistance for Armenian citizens that may discount the cost of education by up to an additional 90%. International students are eligible for merit-based scholarships of up to 50% of the cost of tuition.

Financial aid options include but are not limited to:

Tuition Assistance (Armenian Citizens Only)*

Grants supporting academically gifted students ranging between 25% to 90% of tuition. Grants are awarded based on demonstrated financial need as determined by the Financial Aid Committee based on various factors.

International Scholarship

Merit-based scholarships covering up to 50% of the cost of international tuition. You are eligible if you do not hold Armenian citizenship or the 10-year special residency.

Merit Scholarships*

AUA also provides a limited number of merit scholarships* for continuing students. These awards typically cover half the cost of annual tuition and are subject to the availability of funds.

MOESCS Scholarships

Each year, the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture, and Sport of the Republic of Armenia allocates a number of full scholarships to citizens of Armenia. Scholarships are distributed amongst various programs and awarded based on merit.

Lebanon Emergency Fund

Partial or full need-based scholarships for citizens of Lebanon impacted by the Beirut Explosion. If eligible, you may receive funding for tuition and university housing.

Student Loans

Heavily subsidized student loans offered in partnership with Byblos Bank/Armenia. Detailed information available in **finaid.aua.am/loans-for-graduate-students**.

Installment Payment Plan

Students automatically receive payment plans that divide the total cost of tuition into eight equal installments paid throughout the academic year.

Deferred Payment*

You may apply for a deferred payment that allows you to pay up to 50% of your tuition balance during the course of your studies and up to two years after graduation.

Work-Study

Starting from the second semester of studies, students in good academic standing may apply for paid, on-campus employment opportunities.
