About the TOEFL iBT Test

The TOEFL iBT is an internet-based test that measures your ability to use and understand English at the university level. It also evaluates how well you combine your listening, reading, speaking, and writing skills to perform academic tasks. The test is accepted by more than 11,000 universities and other institutions in over 150 countries, including Australia, Canada, New Zealand, the United States, the U.K., and across Europe and Asia.

Due to COVID-19, ETS rolled out a Home Edition test available from the comfort of your home. AUA accepts both the TOEFL iBT and TOEFL Home Edition tests.

Where and when can I take the TOEFL iBT Test?

To learn more about the locations and available test dates, please log into your account at **ets.org/toefl**. Make sure to make a note of your username and password at the time of registration. The TOEFL iBT is offered more than 60 times a year. You can take the test as many times as you wish, but you cannot take it more than once in a 12-day period. **Your scores are valid for 2 years from the date you took the exam.**

How much does the TOEFL iBT test cost?

The TOEFL iBT test fee for test-takers in the Republic of Armenia is \$200 per test. This fee is set by ETS and may be subject to change without prior notice. You can pay the fee online by using an electronic method of payment (Visa or Mastercard) or you can make a cash payment at the American University of Armenia and receive a voucher from AUA Open Education to register online. Registration closes 7 days before your test date. Late registration closes four days before your test date and has a late fee of \$40. In the event that you need to change your test date, you will be charged a \$60 rescheduling fee. If you need to order additional test scores, you will be charged \$20 each. How can I prepare for the TOEFL iBT Test?

ETS offers a variety of paid and free preparatory materials to help you prepare for the TOEFL iBT test (refer to www.ets.org/toefl/test-takers/ **ibt/prepare**). There are also extensive free and paid study materials available online to help you prepare for standardized exams. Examples include Duolingo, Khan Academy, Kaplan Test Prep, Number2 Online Education, PrepFactory, SparkNotes, ACT, College Board, ETS, British Council, Magoosh, WizlQ, TestDen, and more. In addition, the American University of Armenia has test preparatory resources available at the AGBU Papazian Library (library. aua.am). AUA Open Education also provides TOEFL iBT preparatory courses regularly throughout the year. These courses strengthen your test-taking skills by preparing you for all four components of the TOEFL iBT exam.

How to Register for the TOEFL iBT

- 1. Visit ETS's official website at www.ets.org/toefl.
- 2. Create an Account or Sign-In if you already have an account. (If you have already taken an exam and would like to submit an additional score report, jump to point 10b.)

Note: While opening the account ensure you include your correct personal information and other details as it appears in your passport. Make sure to store your password in a safe place. You will need your password each time you log into your account.

- 3. Once you log into your account, click on the "Register / Find Test Centers Dates" tab on the left side of your screen under "My Tests".
- 4. Select "TOEFL iBT", your desired location, and your two month period during which you would like to take the test. Click on "Continue".
- 5. Carefully consider the test dates and the address and click on "Show Test Times and Register." Once you choose a date, click on register.
- 6. Read the Terms and Conditions of the test administration, click on "I acknowledge and understand the terms and conditions ... " to proceed.
- 7. Enter your Passport (or National ID) number. Click "Next" to proceed.
- **8**. Double check your Personal Information and click on "Next" to proceed.
- 9. On the Free Score Recipients page, in the provided space, insert "4151" for the American University of Armenia to get your official score report. Click on "Add to My Score Recipients to finalize.

NOTE: If you request that your scores be sent to an institution or agency, you will not be able to request a score review.

- 10a. Click on "Online score report and a paper copy mailed to you" for you to receive your scores as well.
- **10b**. IMPORTANT: If you have already taken the exam but did not report your score to AUA, log in to your account to submit an additional score report request.
 - 1. Click on the "Send Additional Score Reports" under the "Scores" tab in the middle of your page.
 - 2. Select "TOEFL Services" and click on "Send Additional Score Report(s) to Institutions".
 - 3. Select from your available test dates and click continue. Enter AUA's institution code number 4151 and select "American U of Armenia, OAKLAND CA 94612" from the search results. Then jump to point 14 below. If you do not indicate the code at the time of registration, you will be charged an additional amount when ordering a score report.
- **11.** Review your test registration and click on "Next" once confirmed.
- **12.** Review your order summary, you can add in course preparations to your cart, and if everything is correct click on "Next" and later on "Proceed to Checkout."
- 13. Make the payment at the time of registration to secure your seat at the test center.

Note: If you do not make the payment at the time of registration, your seat will not be confirmed and reserved.

- 14. Print your Confirmation Letter and take it along with you on the test day. You must present the same passport with which you have registered to be allowed to take the test.
