Tuition & Fees

Applicants shall apply for financial aid at the same time they apply for AUA admission. It is not possible to apply for financial aid after the applicant receives Admission. Submitting a financial aid application will not affect your admission process nor decision.

Admitted students sign a contract upon enrollment that establishes their tuition for the duration of their studies. All fees are paid in AMD (3).

- Citizens of the Republic of Armenia*
- Holders of Armenian Special Passport for Special Residency Status
- International Students

Financial Aid at AUA

Invest in your education today. **Secure** a sustainable, rewarding **tomorrow**. AUA practices 100% need-blind admissions. The university will help its students finance their studies by offering various tools available to support their educational journey.

Citizens of the Republic of Armenia and Armenian Special Passport Holders receive an automatic 2,000,000 AMD (4) annual subsidy off the total cost of their tuition. In addition, the University offers need-based and merit-based tuition assistance for Armenian citizens that may additionally cover up to 90% of the reduced tuition. International students are also eligible for merit-based scholarships that may cover up to 50% of the total cost of tuition.

Financial aid options include but are not limited to:

Tuition Assistance (Armenian Citizens Only)*

Designed for academically gifted students who require additional financial support to be able to attend AUA. Tuition assistance may range from 25% to 90% of the tuition costs. Students must maintain good academic standing to continue receiving tuition assistance each semester.

International Scholarship

Merit-based scholarships covering up to 50% of the cost of international tuition. Students are eligible for this scholarship if they do not hold Armenian citizenship or the 10-year special residency.

Installment Payment Plan

Students automatically receive payment plans that divide the total cost of tuition into eight equal installments paid throughout the academic year.

Tuition Assistance

For fall 2022 we have:

- 291 financial aid applicants from the group of newly admitted class of undergraduate 1st year students (the figure includes the group of BSN who did not apply for need-based aid, however received 95% automatic reductions according to the established procedure)
- 221 financial aid recipients
- 65% average reduction in annual tuition

Deferred Payment*

Allows you to pay up to 50% of your tuition balance during the course of your studies and the remainder within two years after graduation.

Merit Scholarships*

AUA also provides a limited number of merit scholarships* for continuing students. These awards typically cover half the cost of annual tuition and are subject to the availability of funds.

Work-Study


Starting from the second semester of studies, students in good academic standing may apply for paid, on-campus employment opportunities.
