

Tuition & Fees

Admitted students sign a contract upon enrollment that establishes their tuition for the duration of their studies. All fees are paid in AMD (֏).

Applicants are classified as:

- Citizens of the Republic of Armenia
- Holders of Armenian Special Passport for Special Residency Status
- International Students

Applicants shall apply for financial aid within the same deadline that they apply for AUA admission. It is not possible to apply for financial aid after the applicant receives Admission. Submitting a financial aid application will not affect your admission process nor decision.

***AUA requires proof of health insurance for students who do not hold Armenian citizenship. You may purchase health insurance from any provider, or secure it through AUA

IMPORTANT NOTICE Students admitted to the BS in Nursing program will receive an automatic subsidy of 95% of tuition, provided they are citizens of the Republic of Armenia.

Admission Requirements

- **Complete application** including all required supplements
- **Proof of high school graduation** or equivalent
- **Proof of English Language Proficiency** through:
 - TOEFL iBT
 - IELTS Academic
 - English Language Proficiency Test Waiver
- **Proof of Math proficiency*** through the math sections of:
 - SAT
 - ACT

*English & Communications and Nursing applicants are waived from this requirement for Fall 2024.

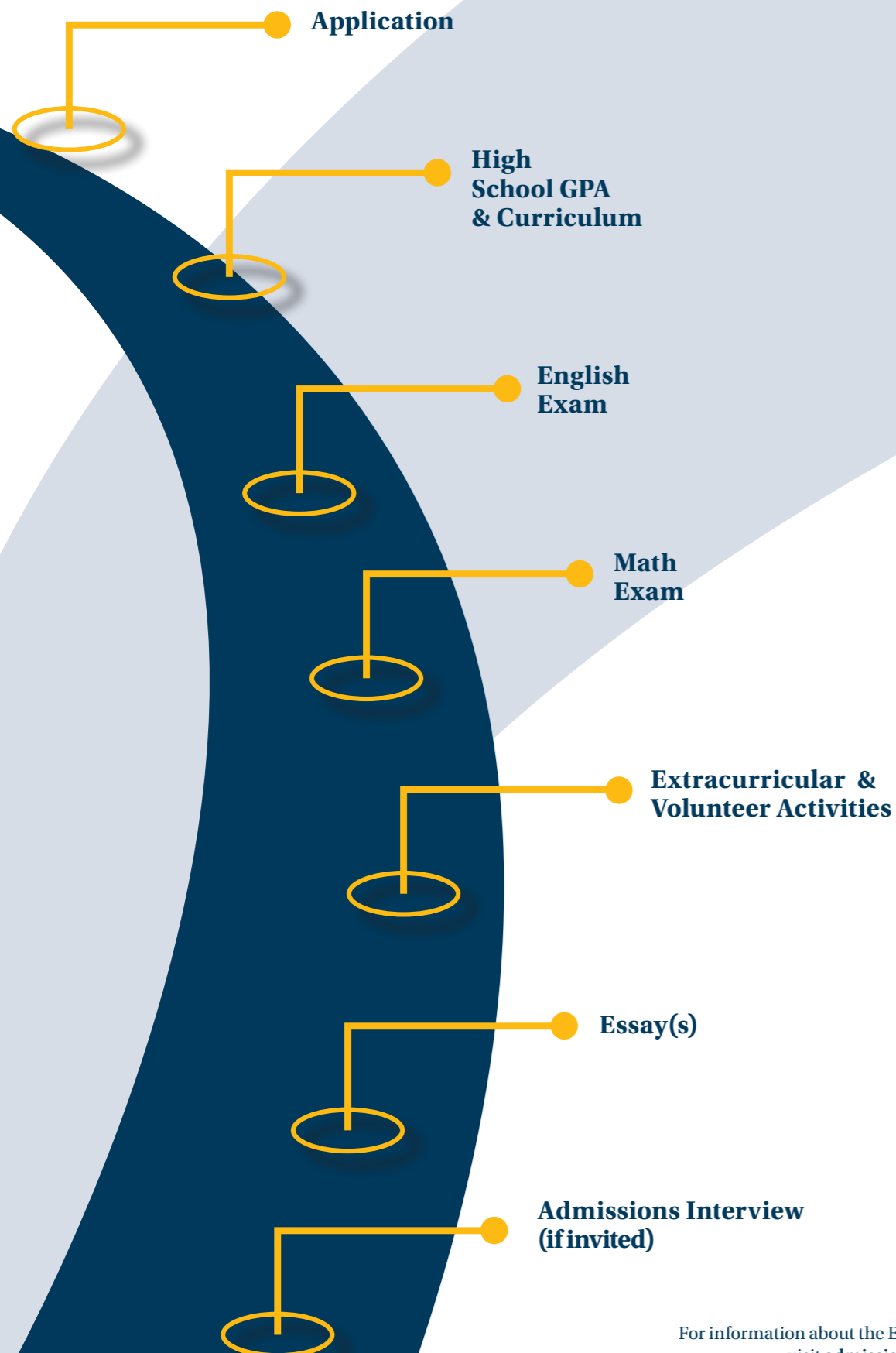

Selection Process

AUA practices holistic admissions. The Office of Admissions conducts a thorough technical review ensuring that you have met all application requirements. Once the Office of Admissions deems an application complete, it is forwarded to the respective Academic program for evaluation and recommendation; afterwards, the Undergraduate Admissions Committee reviews and makes the final decision. Undergraduate Financial Aid at AUA

AUA practices need-blind admissions: no qualified applicant is denied admission due to inability to pay. Furthermore, the university is committed to supporting students in finding means to finance their education through various financial aid or scholarship opportunities. Citizens of the Republic of Armenia and Armenian Special Passport Holders receive an automatic 2,000,000 AMD (₴) annual subsidy off the total international tuition. In addition, the University offers need-based and merit-based financial aid for Armenian citizens that may additionally cover up to 90% of the reduced tuition. International students are also eligible for merit-based scholarships that may cover up to 50% of the total cost of tuition.

- Installment Payment Plan
- Deferred Payment*
- Merit Scholarships*
- Work-Study
